Misdemeanor Diversion Program

CURRICULUM

The Misdemeanor Diversion Program utilizes the ARISE curriculum. The ARISE curriculum is an evidence-based program that focuses on life skills for at-risk youth. These sessions are set up in a manner that the facilitator teaches the importance of topics (such as values/goals and decision making) in a group or one-on-one to emphasize that the youth needs to be motivated to make better decisions. In addition, lessons (such as self esteem and character) are sent home with the youth for critical thinking and self realization. This material will be used as a discussion topic at the next session, along

with completing the post test with a better

understanding than the pretest.
