Founded in 1996 as an intervention model for Durham's adjudicated teens, the PROUD Program has expanded its outreach programs to include a summer enrichment program for youth ages 7-12 years old.

With 21 years of solid experience providing services for youth and their families, PROUD is now considered one of the model programs working with disconnected youth in Durham, North Carolina.

#### **Our MISSION**

The purpose of our program is to foster responsible behavior among Durham's young people, to deter court-referred youth from becoming repeat offenders, and to decrease the dropout rate of students in Durham school.

#### **OUR SUCCESS**

In 2016/2017 of our graduates had no adjudications since graduating from the program.

PROUD has worked with 64 Misdemeanor Diversion Program youth and only 1 has reoffended.

All Summer Enrichment participates advanced to their next grade level.

#### **DEAC Program**

Drug Education and Counseling!

PROUD will provide education services to students from Durham Public Schools who

has violated Policy 4301 for alcohol or drugs.

The program will focus on Substance Abuse Education using the ARISE curriculum.

The DEAC Program is a 4 session program that take place at the PROUD office 118 E. Main St.

#### **Bullying Program**

PROUD will provide Bullying services to students from Durham Public Schools as an alternative program.

## STOP BULLYING NOW!

### PROUD GUIDELINES

Parents must make initial contact **NOT** the student.

All office visits are by appointment only **NO** walk-ins.

Parent must attend orientation/intake with youth.

Parents must bring suspension paper work to orientation/intake.

To receive credit for both programs client must attend all four (4) sessions.

The program is from 4:30pm-6:30pm twice a week for two weeks.

The program will notify school when youth complete or fail to comply with program.
